

ITINERARY

July 2 GLASGOW

Upon arrival in Glasgow, Scotland, you will meet your host and fellow guests at the hotel to check in for one night. We will wander the gorgeous buildings at the University. The cloisters make for great Architectural photography. Later that night we will photograph the Clyde Arc Bridge beautifully lit up and reflecting in the river.

Overnight in Glasgow at Best Western Garfield House.

July 3-4 ISLE OF ARRAN (B)*

After breakfast at the hotel we will drive to the Isle of Arran which includes a short ferry ride.

Brodick Castle is one of the highlights of the Isle of Arran. Nearby is Goatfell, a hill that's a popular day hike. With gorgeous views. The Machrie Moor stone circles make for a fabulous nearby trip at sunset as well as a tour of The Arran Malt whisky distillery. If weather permits, Glenashdale Falls and Kings Cave will be a great experience.

Check in at the Best Western Kinloch for 2 nights.

July 5 GLENCOE (B)

After breakfast, we will check out and begin a scenic drive to Glencoe. It may be a short ride by car but this will take us much longer because of the amount of stops we will be making. Glencoe is one of my favourite places in Scotland. You will be in awe of the shear size of these mountains.

If weather and time permits, we will stop to photograph the Glenfinnan Viaduct (Harry Potter train).

Overnight at Ben Nevis Hotel.

July 6 DORNIE (B)

One of Scotland's most picturesque castles awaits us in Dornie: Eilean Donan Castle. We will photograph every beautiful inch of this gorgeous structure. Our hotel is just a short walk to the castle and perfect for photographing this historic castle at night. Weather permitting, we will be photographing the castle at dawn. For those interested in wildlife photography, we will go on the Reraig Forest tour for Red Deer.

Overnight at the Sealladg Mara B&B.

July 7-10 ISLE OF SKYE (B)

For such a small island, it packs a punch for landscape photography. These 4 days are packed with the following: colourful Portree Village, Kilt Rock, Mealt Falls, The Quiraing, Ol' Man of Storr, The Fairy Glen, The Fairy Pools, Brother's Point, Neist Point, Dunvegan Castle, Talisker Distillery and The Cuillins.

On arrival we will check into the Eilean Iarmain Hotel for the next 4 nights.

July 11-12 STIRLING (B)

Stirling Castle is high on a hill overlooking lush greenery. We will definitely make time stopping off at Falkirk just before sunset for the Kelpies. They are lit up at night and this stop will add to your nighttime photography. Wallace Monument is not to be forgotten and if you are an Outlander fan, you will love our stop at Doune Castle.

Overnight at the Holiday Inn Express Stirling.

July 13 GLASGOW (B)

After breakfast we will head back to Glasgow where we will check into the Best Western Garfield House for our last night.
